Subject: Notification of Intent (NOI) to issue an Invitation for International Bidding (IFIB) for the Supply of a Satellite Automatic Identification System (AIS) to HQ MC Northwood and JFC Naples.

1. In accordance with the stipulations of the BI-SC procurement Directive 60-70, Annex B, the following information is provided on an Invitation for International Bidding (IFIB) that this Headquarters has the intention to release.

IFIB Reference number : ACO-MANW-11-51
 Title of Requirement : Satellite Automated Identification System (AIS) Service

- The service must be able to provide complete global AIS coverage, within reason, allowing access to all AIS transmitting ships.
- The satellite AIS systems feeding the data service must have a minimum of 75% probability of single pass detection ratio.
- All provided data must have been de-conflicted and integrated in order to prevent duplicated reports on a single ship.
- The data is to be transmitted as close as to real-time (e.g. zero latency) as practicable but the time late when received at the HQ must never exceed three (3) hours.
- The data service must be flexible and adaptable to allow for a change of the boundaries of the agreed Named Areas of Interest.
- The data service must be able to provide the ability to set up and deliver a new Named Area of Interest at short notice.
- The service provider must be able to deliver a historical data facility.
- Delivery of the Satellite AIS data should be automated and delivered to the following two (2) systems:
 1. To the Maritime Safety and Security Information System (MSSIS) via the Transmission Control Protocol/Internet Protocol and IEC 61993-2 AIS standards.
 2. To the Baseline for Rapid Iterative Transformational Experimentation (BRITE) system via the Transmission Control Protocol/Internet Protocol and IEC 61993-2 AIS standards.
