

The object of the contract is to provide Force Protection related works in merging the function of the Southern ECP (known as Abbey Gate), with that of the recently constructed East Gate ECP, which formed the first phase of the project at Kabul Afghanistan International Airfield (KAIA) – North. Project implementation includes civil and force protection works.

In particular, these works consist of demining the affected area, construction of security fences, relocation of containerised facilities and of movable concrete walls, construction of blast resistant structures including ancillary works such as concrete and asphalt pavements.

The total cost of the project is estimated at the amount of EUR 1,000,000.
