Dnipropetrovsk region is located in the south-eastern part of Ukraine, in the basin of the middle and lower courses of the Dnipro river, at the crossing of motor roads, railways and waterways, that combines east and west (European Route **E50**) and North-South (European Route **E105**) to the European Continent. The administrative center of the region is the city of Dnipro, that located on both banks of the similiary-named river.

In the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region there is the Eastern European time EET (UTC + 2), with the swith to daylight saving time EEST (UTC + 3). The territory of the region is 31,9 thousand km², which is 5,3% of the territory of Ukraine. The length from north to south is 130 km, from west to east is 300 km. The average altitude ranges between 100 and 200 meters above sea level.

Dnipropetrovsk region is located in the steppe and forest-steppe zones (forests occupy 3,9% of the region area). From the northwest to the south-east the region crossed by the Dnipro river, with its developed river transport infrastructure, the basin of this river includes its tributary streams, such as Oril, Samara, Suras, Bazavluk, Inhulets and others. In the south, river is bordered by the waters of the Kakhovka Reservoir, with the corresponding river ports.

In the region there are about 1,5 thousd. reservoirs and ponds with area of more than 26 thousd. ha. There is also a well-developed system of melioration. The climate is moderately continental and characterized by relatively cool winters and warm summers. The average annual temperature varies between +7 - +9 °C. The coldest month is January (-5 - -7 °C), the warmest month is July (+22 - +23 °C). The annual rainfall is 430 - 490 mm. The duration of vegetation period lasts 210 days. The solar activity during the year is 240 days on average. The level of solar radiation is 1 300 - 1 450 kW/m². Due to the diversity and importance of natural resources, Dnipropetrovsk region is one of the richest in Ukraine. The fertile black soils are prevailed almost in all territory of the region.

The extensive irrigation system suitable for intensive agriculture. Dnipropetrovsk region is rich in minerals. There are significant mineral reserves of iron and manganese ores, stone and brown coal, rare and non-ferrous metals.

The number of permanent residents of Dnipropetrovsk region as of January 1, 2017 according the estimation, amounted to 3 227,1 thousd. people. Among them 2 695,1 thousd. people (83,5%) are residents of urban settlements and 532,0 thousd. people (16,5%) are residents of rural areas.

In the structure of the regional population 54,3% (1 751,5 thousd. people) are women and 45,7% (1 475,6 thousd. people) are men. The representatives of more than 30 nationalities are living in the territory of the region, namely: Russians (17,6%), Belarusians (0,8%), Jews (0,4%), Armenians (0,3%), Azeris (0,2%), Moldovans (0,12%) and others.

Dnipropetrovsk region is the main labor market in the south-east part of Ukraine, which is dynamically developing. Many companies have removed their offices to Dnipro from the eastern part of Ukraine.

There are 1 508,6 thousd. people of economically active population of workable age in the region. The level of registered unemployment (according to the methodology of the International Labor Organization) as of January 1, 2017 equaled to 8,1%.

There are 30,7 thousd. people of unemployed population. Among them 22,0 thousd. people are residents of urban settlements and 8,7 thousd. people (16,5%) are residents of rural areas. The average monthly salary in the region for 2017 amounted to USD 250.

EDUCATION

Dnipropetrovsk region is one of the leading academic centers of Ukraine. In the region, as of the beginning of 2016-2017, there are:

In «Top 20 Ukraine» ranking, 3 Higher Education Institutions of Dnipropetrovsk region hold leading positions:

- Technical University «Dnipro Polytechnic»;
- Oles Honchar Dnipropetrovsk National University;
- National Metallurgical Academy of Ukraine.

The development of regional transport system is determined by the high level of production concentration and densely-populated area. Its transport network is an integral part of Ukraine entire network. The aviation, railway, automobile, pipeline and river transport is developed in the region. In the period of 2013-2016's region occupies a leading position in terms of freight traffic, namely 366,4 mln tons by railway transport, 1,7 mln tons by river transport, 1,3 bln tons by road transport and 6,3 thousd tons by air transport.

HIGHWAY TRANSPORTATION OPERATION

The highway transport is one of the key types of goods and passengers transportation, including on international routes.

The territory is crossed by two European routes E50 (Paris - Prague - Uzhhorod - Vinnytsia - Dnipro) and E105 (Kirkenes (Norway) - Kharkiv - Novomoskovsk - Simferopil). Three national highways H11 (Dnipro – Mykolaiv – Odesa), H08 (Dnipro – Kyiv), H23 (Kropyvnytskyi – Kryvyi Rih – Nikopol, Zaporizhzhia) connect Dnipropetrovsk region with seaports, capital and industrial centers of the region.

The largest transportation hub of the region is the city of Dnipro. The highways network connects it with all towns and urban type settlement of the region and other regions of Ukraine. The length of public roads in Dnipropetrovsk region is 9 166,6 km, including roads of national significance – 2 998,0 km and roads of local significance – 6 182,6 km.

BUS STATIONS

In the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region there is a forked network of bus stations of «Dnipropetrovsk regional bus station enterprise», PJSC (total 34), which combines cities and regional centers of the region. The inter-city communication is made with all regional centers of Ukraine.

The central bus station in Dnipro is the second in Europe (after the bus station in Hamburg) in terms of its size and passenger traffic capacity. It can receive and send 3 100 buses and 124 thousand passengers per day.

RAILWAY TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

The railway transportation is the main mode of Dnipropetrovsk region transport. By saturation with railways, the region is the leader in the state.

The developed network of railway tracks of regional branch „Prydniprovskia Zaliznytsia” of Ukrzaliznytsia Private Joint Stock Company in the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region is 1 023,7 km against the entire operational length of 3 208 km.

The main part of the goods transportation is carried out on such sites as:

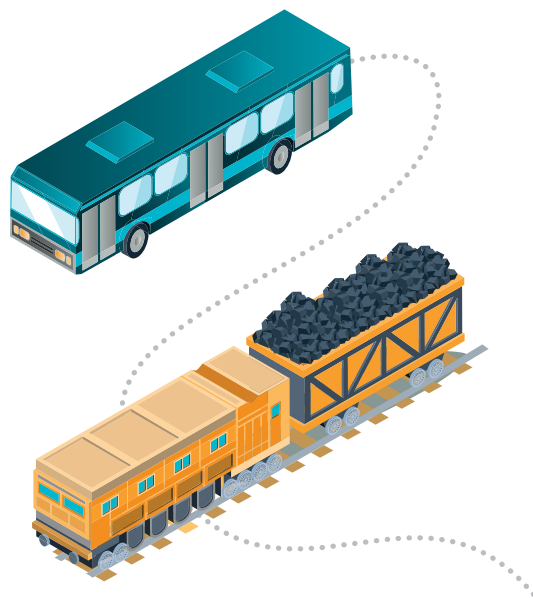
Chaplyne – Synelnykove – Nyzhnodniprovsk – Verkhivtseve – Piatykhvatky; Zaporizhzhia – Apostolove – Kryvyi Rih – Dolynska; Pokrovsk – Pavlohrad – Novomoskovsk – Kamianske.

Almost a half of all cargoes that are sent by rail are iron and manganese ore of the Kryvyi Rih and Nikopol basins. In the region, only 1/3 of this ore is transported by railway road, and the rest is sent to metallurgical plants and exports. Building materials ranks second in the structure of cargoes that are sent by Prydniprovskia railway road, ferrous metals ranks third.

Among the cargoes received by Prydniprovskia railway road stations are predominated coal,

which is exported from Western Donbass, iron ore, auxiliary metallurgical raw materials and construction materials. The largest senders of ferrous metals are Kryvyi Rih and Dnipro, building materials and fluxes - stations adjacent to the Nikopol port.

The main flow of transit cargo is sent to the Black Sea ports in Kherson and Mykolaiv, as well as for export to the West. In the flow of transit cargo the main role is played by coal, ferrous metals, grain and timber cargoes.

RAILWAY HUBS:

Nyzhnodniprovsk-Vuzol, Dnipro, Synelnykove-2, Pavlohrad-1, Novomoskovsk-Dniprovskiyi, Kamianske, Apostolove, Kryvyi Rih, Piatykhatky.

Dnipro branch of «Center of Transport Service «Liski» of the Ukrainian Railways Public Joint Stock Company (Dnipro, 3, Krotov Str., www.liski.ua) includes a network of rail freight terminals that offer:

- customs complex with the representatives of state customs control, environmental and phytosanitary control;
- arrival place of highway transport with cargo under customs control;
- covered warehouse hangar type;
- platform for the processing of heavy goods which, is equipped with gantry cranes (with the possibility of connecting an electromagnetic washer to unload metal from gondola cars);
- platforms for processing 3-tons, 5-tons, 20-tons, 40-foot containers.

All cargo facilities have the ability to simultaneously service rail and road vehicles.

To meet the needs of customers, the department has production sites in such cities of Dnipropetrovsk region as: Kamianske, Pavlohrad, Novomoskovsk, Synelnykove and settlements: Pokrovka, Vasylykivka, Partyzanske.

RIVER TRANSPORT

From north to south, Dnipropetrovsk region is crossed by the main water artery of the country the Dnipro river. Dnipro, Kamianske and Nikopol river ports of JSSC «Ukrrihflot», and PJSC «Dniprodzerzhinsk river port» operated in region. The vessels of the «river-sea» type provide direct international cargo transportation with access to the Black, Marmara and Mediterranean seas.

The largest river port of Ukraine is located in the city of Dnipro. Due to its favorable geographic

position, it fully meets the needs of adjacent industrial regions in the transportation, storage of various metal, grain, coal, containers, etc.

AIR TRANSPORT

In Dnipropetrovsk region there are two international airports and cargo terminal that connect the region with countries of the far and near abroad.

The international airport «Dnipropetrovsk» (DNK) is «4C» class. Runway strip: length - 2850 m, width - 44 m. The international air transportations are carried out by aircrafts of Boeing, Airbus, Embraer, AN and others. The airport accepts helicopters and light aircraft of all types, around the clock. There is 1 operating terminal with a capacity of 700 passengers per hour.

The cargo air transportation is carried out by the Aviation Transport Company «Yuzhmashavia» (www.yuzmashair.com.ua). It has an airfield complex in the territory of Dnipropetrovsk airport with an area of 22,7 ha. This complex includes certified parking for aircraft, commercial warehouses, production facilities and areas where airfield engineering, equipment, in-flight tanker force are located.

The airline provides logistics services. During loading and unloading operations, forklift and telpher are used in warehouses. The territory is protected by modern video surveillance systems. The company has its own IL-76TD, UR-78785 and UR-78786 aircraft, the cargo cabin of which is 220 m³. This allows to carry out cargo transportation of oversized and super heavy cargo to the CIS countries, Asia, Africa and Europe.



PIPELINE TRANSPORTATION

The pipeline transportation is of a great importance. It provides regional districts with oil, oil products, gas, coming mainly from other regions. The pipeline transport has a dense network of gas pipelines that supply natural gas to all industrial centers and many rural settlements of the region. The gas pipelines connect the Shebelinka gas field (Kharkiv region) with such cities as: Dnipro, Kryvyi Rih, Nikopol and Kamianske.

COMMUNICATIONS

The telecommunication infrastructure is successfully developing in the region. The mainstream fiber-optic and wireless data transmission channels are created, providing high-quality telecommunication services to all consumers in the region.

The region is provided with mobile communication of GSM and CDMA standards. Most of the territories are covered by high-speed wireless Internet using 3G technology.

The introduction of information technology and modern postal equipment allows to organize the provision of electronic and hybrid mail services, implement banking operations, various types of settlements and provide information services.

AGRICULTURAL LOGISTICS

For grain and industrial crops storage there are 68 grain storage facilities with a total capacity of 2 520,8 thousd. tons in Dnipropetrovsk region. In addition, agricultural enterprises have 1 522 grain storage facilities with a total capacity of 1 858,7 thousd. tons, so the total storage capacity of grain and industrial crops is 4 379,5 thousd. tons.

The total number of storehouses in the region is 62 units, including vegetables - 46, potatoes - 9, fruits - 7. The total storage capacity is 173,1 thousd. tons, including for storage of vegetables - 84,9 thousd. tons, potatoes - 59,8 thousd. tons, fruit - 28,4 thousd. tons. The stores with refrigeration equipment make up 105,9 thousd. tons from the total capacity.

An extensive network of modern elevators has been created in the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region. This network ensures the reception and transshipment of goods by road, rail and river transport. The practice of building elevators, storage facilities and refrigerators becomes mainstream among regional farmers. These facilities are being built in compliance with modern and European standards, in order to

increase exports and bring products to the market in the optimal period. The number of modern elevators is growing every year and this direction is investment attractive.

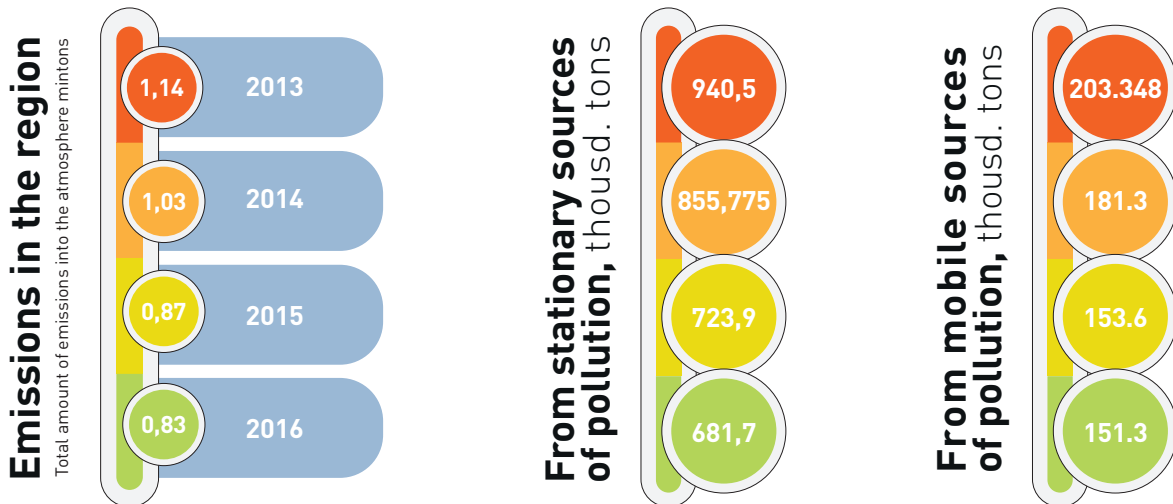


According to the Strategy for the Development of Dnipropetrovsk region for the period up to 2020 ecological safety and climate protection defined as one of key priorities of region's development. The main directions of environmental activity are focused on:

- improvement of ecological state of the Dnipro basin;
- reduction of atmospheric air pollution level;
- assistance in solving waste management problems (firstly, toxic and insufficient waste);
- expansion of the nature reserve fund area and formation of regional ecological network;
- reforestation and extension of their area, preservation of biological and terrains diversity, protection of flora, fauna and forest ecosystems;
- improvement of environmental monitoring system of the region;
- improvement of the public awareness and assistance in its participation in the decision-making;
- process on environmental issues.

ATMOSPHERIC AIR

As a result of economic decisions implementation in the region, positive dynamics of pollutants emission reductions has been formed.



Within the framework of the volunteer project EcoInfo, IT-specialists of the region developed online service that allows you to get information about the environmental situation at set point.

According to the requested geolocation on the web-site www.ecoinfo.pro you can get information on environmental condition in the form of data eco-layers (air pollutants, landfills, hydrometeorology, water quality, soil, etc.). The service also provides information on pollutants within a radius of 5 to 50 km from the requested point.

ENERGY-EFFICIENT OFFERS

The significant projects are being implemented in Dnipropetrovsk region under the Program to Support the Green Modernization of the Ukrainian Economy in cooperation with the German governmental organization Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH. These projects are aimed to promote the ideas of green economic development:

- create the conditions for implementation of modern and environmentally safe means of production;
- analyze the obstacles that prevent companies from investing in new technologies;
- promote professional exchange between enterprises and communicate with public authorities.

In the framework of Green Chamber Initiative for Sustainable Development project, there has been established the Committee of Green Technology Providers in order to implement energy-efficient and environmentally friendly technologies adoption, which offers to enterprises the following services:

- energy audit;
- development of recommendations on the basis of technical and economic analysis;
- development of energy saving and rational energy usage program;
- determining priority of proposed measures based on the costs analysis and project payback;
- energy management system construction;
- creation of enterprise energy management system with the possibility of certification according to international «TÜV SÜD» standards;
- ecological support (eco-outsourcing);
- organization of environmental work;
- organization of generated waste calculation;
- regular measurement of pollution sources;
- obtaining permits and emission limits;
- preparation and submission of relevant reports on the formation, treatment of I-III hazard classes waste disposal, atmospheric air protection, water usage, environmental protection costs.

Green Solutions for Business – Unity for Sustainable Development project aims at spreading the practices of energy-efficient, resource-saving management among economic entities by means of Dnipropetrovsk region enterprise database formation. This database will include enterprises, which are used green technologies, develop, produce or import them.

The base of green solutions will cover 400 enterprises: 30-40 large, 150-200 middle ones, others - private enterprises, etc.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

Dnipropetrovsk region cooperates with 23 partner regions from 12 countries in the framework of concluded bilateral agreements. The most active cooperation is with the Lower Silesia Voivodship (Poland), the Bratislava region (Slovakia) and the region of Yas-Nagykun-Szolnok (Hungary). At the level of the regions' cities, there were concluded 18 agreements on partnerships with cities in 15 countries of the world.

VISA APPLICATION CENTERS

In the regional visa application center there are 15 visa application centers of the EU member states, which provide an opportunity to obtain visas for training and internships.

INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS

As part of the implementation of joint international projects, Dnipropetrovsk region actively cooperates with international organizations, in particular GIZ (Germany), DESPRO (Switzerland), USAID (USA), United Nations Development Program, CIDA (Canada) in the development of social communities' infrastructure in connection with the increase of Internally Displaced Persons, the introduction of energy-efficient solutions of enterprises and communities in the region, the creation of dairy and grain cooperatives, providing the population with quality drinking water. In two years, international support amounted to more than USD 8 mln.

DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR OFFICES

In the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region there are 7 diplomatic institutions, in particular the General Consulate of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Israeli Cultural Center in Dnipro at the Embassy of the State of Israel in Ukraine.

The region has a strong industrial potential. It is characterized by a high level of heavy industry development. The enterprises of mining and smelting complex account for 60,3% of all sold products of the region. In the region there are more than 500 industrial enterprises of almost all types of economic activity.

In Dnipropetrovsk region, 18,4% (USD 11,8 bln) of all sold industrial output of Ukraine is produced.

By this indicator, the region ranks first in Ukraine.

MINING INDUSTRY

In 2016, the turnover of raw materials amounted to 33,9% of the national and 24,0% of the total industrial production of the region.

The reserves of coal and brown coal of the region make up more than 21 bln tons. About 18 mln tons of coal is produced annually, accounting for almost 25% of the total production in Ukraine. OJSC «DTEK Pavlohraduhillia» deals with extraction.

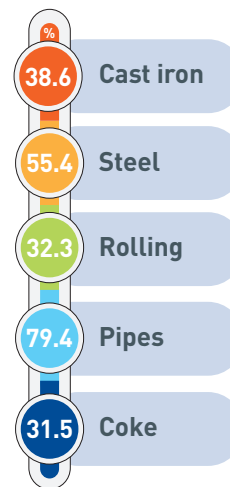
The base of regional mining industry consists of 10 mining companies, which extract iron, manganese and rare earth ore.

PROCESSING INDUSTRY

The processing industry of the region provides 16,4% of the national volume of industrial products sales. The volume of sold products is USD 6,8 bln or 57,6% of all sold industrial output in the region. The basis of the region's industry is metallurgy. The volumes of sold products make up 34,4% of the total volume in the region.

The pipes of large and small diameters, hollow profile of hot and cold deformation, centrifugal casting are produced at the pipe enterprises of the region («Interpipe Nyzhniodniprovsk Tube Rolling Plant» PJSC, «Interpipe Novomoskovsk Pipe-Production Plant» PJSC, «Interpipe Niko Tube» Ltd, «Centravis Production Ukraine» PJSC and others) by means of welding method.

The production of pipe-rolling enterprises of the region is exported to almost 70 countries of the world.

The products are exported to more than 35 countries of the world and amounted to 39,5% of the volumes of ferrous metallurgy production in Ukraine.

CHEMICAL INDUSTRY

The production of the industry accounts for 17,9% of the production volume of the chemical and petrochemical industry of Ukraine. The volume of sales in the field of chemical substances and chemical production is 4,2% of industrial production in the region.

The paint and varnish production is one of the largest in Ukraine. Taking into account environmentally friendly new technologies, over 120 types of paint and varnish products have been mastered.

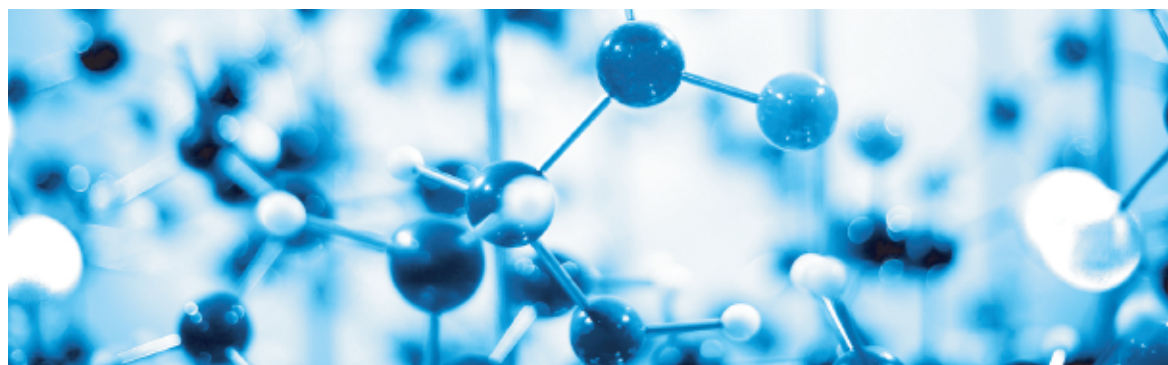
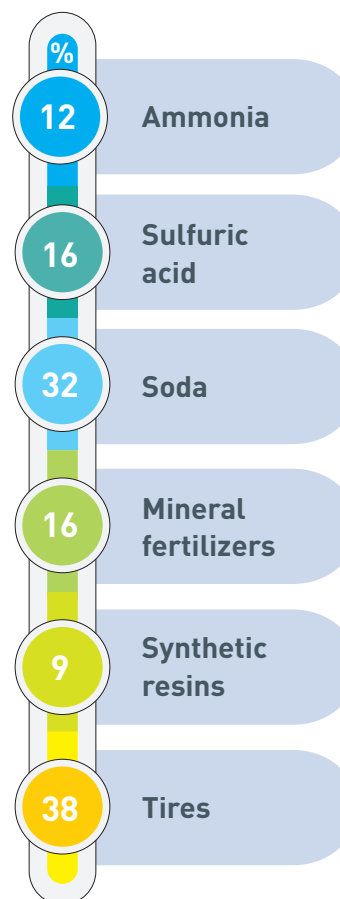
In Dnipropetrovsk region, the Subsidiary Enterprise «Caparol Ukraine», enterprise of one of the world’s leading manufacturers of high-quality front and interior paints is successfully operating.

The production of «Dniproazot», PJSC, one of the largest chemical enterprises of the country, is exported to Asia, Latin America, Central and Eastern Europe.

The largest state-owned enterprise in the chemical industry of the region is the Scientific-Production Association «Pavlohrad Chemical Plant», which specializes in the production of explosives for ore mining and processing enterprises in Ukraine. The scientific developments, software, technologies and products of the company are successfully used in Ukraine and exported to the EU, Southeast Asia, Australia, America and Africa.

Also in Dnipropetrovsk region, the Subsidiary Enterprise «Messer Ukraine», a representative of one of the world’s largest manufacturers of chemical products, is successfully operating.

MANUFACTURE OF RUBBER PRODUCTS

The share of the industry for the production of rubber and plastic products in the region is 3,8% of the total industrial output.

In the region more than 80 standard tires sizes, including large-sized and low pressure for the modern agricultural machinery, which are exported to 30 countries of the world, are mastered and manufactured.

«Ukrainian factory super large tires», Ltd is the only one in Ukraine and CIS countries that produces super large tires for dump trucks with a carrying capacity of 55 to 220 tons. The company's products are exported to Australia, Europe, North and South America, Africa and Southeast Asia.

More than 60 enterprises are engaged in the production of knitted products in the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region, including «Dniprokozhhalantereya», Ltd, «Topline», Ltd, «Fine Fashion of Ukraine», Ltd, «Parsial» and others.





The volume of sold products of the machine-building complex makes up 2,8% of the regional sales volume.

The products of machine building are widely known not only in Ukraine, but also far beyond its borders.

The equipment for:

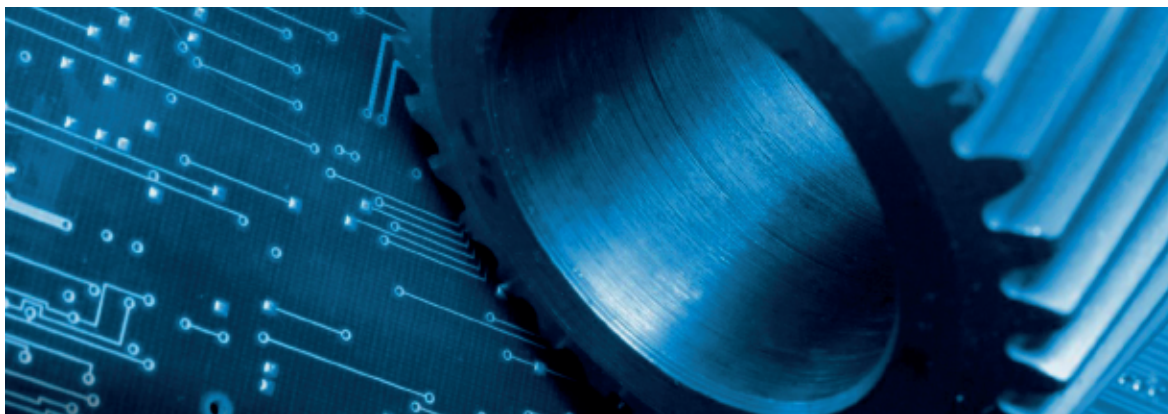

Are being produced at the machine-building enterprises of the region:

- «Dnipropetrovsk Aggregate Plant», PJSC;
- «Dnipropetrovsk Railway Switch Plant», PJSC;
- «Dniprovazhmash», PJSC;
- State Enterprise «Elektrovozobuduvania»;
- «Dniprovahonmash», PJSC and others.

The engineering branch is dynamically developing. Leading enterprises actively implement the latest technologies and carry out technical re-equipment, for example:

- At the PJSC «Dnipropetrovsk Railway Switch Plant» there have been put on production new types of products: 60E1 railroad switch of 1/9 radius of 300 m, 1435 mm rail on reinforced concrete slabs under a project with Iran; tram railroad switch with a turning pen with radius of 50 m; 7 varieties of cross-sections with welded rail endings of 49E1 type for projects with Turkey;
- At «Dnipropetrovs'k Aggregate Plant», PJSC was developed new types of products:
 - DAT-0,09 electric motor;
 - KE-178 dispatcher;
 - HT-30D generator;
 - BRZU-115UD block;
 - 8260-12UD starter-generator;
 - hinged tractor equipment;
 - electromagnetic valves of DMKT, DMKV type.
- At the SE «SPC Elektrovozobuduvania», there has been mastered the production of brake cylinders of the electric stock, the work on the production of dump car test sample of D6D type and adjustment of its serial production is being carried out.



SPACE INDUSTRY

Dnipropetrovsk region is the space capital of Ukraine and one of the world centers of rocket and space engineering.

The high technical equipment and qualification of engineering and working personnel allows developing and producing such environmentally friendly booster rockets as «Zenit» and other space vehicles that are unique.

The industry basis is such domestic enterprises of the space industry as:

- Design Office «Yuzhnoye»;
- The State Enterprise «Production Association Yuzhny Machine-Building Plant named after O.M. Makarov».

The Design Office «Yuzhnoye» participates in international commercial space projects «Sea Launch», «Ground Launch», «Cyclone-4» and «Vega», closely cooperates with aerospace companies of France, USA, Turkey and Brazil.

Taking into account the particular urgency of Earth observation from space, the bureau designers developed a number of Land remote sensing satellite – «Sich-1», «Sich-2», «Egypsat-1» and space systems, including ground control, data acquisition and processing complexes.

Last year, according to NASA's order, the Cygnus transport vehicle with the upgraded Antares-230 launch vehicle delivered 2,3 tons of cargo to the international space station. This project is a joint development of the Design Office «Yuzhnoye» with Orbital Sciences Corporation.

The State Enterprise «Production Association Yuzhny Machine-Building Plant» is a world-class production complex that performs serial production of modern rocket and space



technology samples. The company has mastered and introduced unique technological solutions.

The production complex diversification makes it possible to produce products for the following types of activities:

- defense industry;
- aviation transport;
- agricultural machinery;
- civil products;
- production, testing, operation of spacecraft carrier rockets.

A particular highlight of the region is the «Virtual Aerospace School», which has been working since 2012 and allows young people aged from 12 to 18 years to acquire aerospace education in an interactive mode.

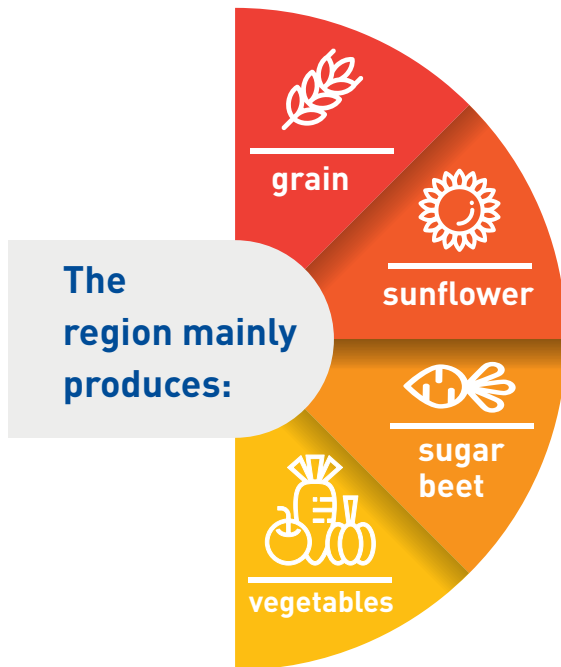

In the region there are more than 4 000 agricultural enterprises.

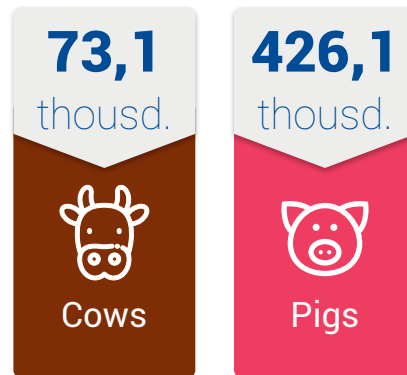
The production of gross agricultural output in Dnipropetrovsk region is 6,0% of the total volume in Ukraine.

The agricultural production is being carried out at 2 999,3 thousand. ha - it is 73,4% of the total area of the region.



According to the results of 2016, farms of all categories received 3,5 mln tons of grain and sold 311 thousand. tons of livestock and poultry.

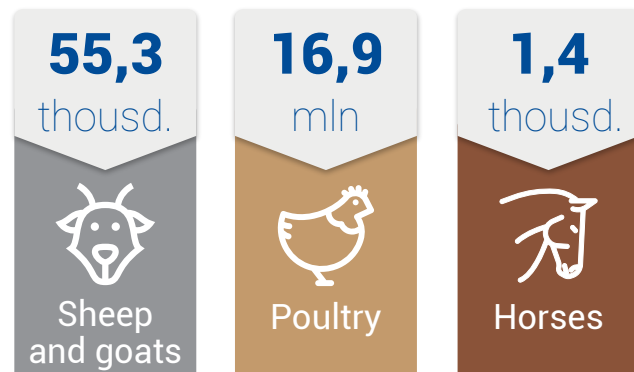
The infrastructure of the agrarian market is developing - in the region there are 62 storage facilities for storing vegetables and fruits, and there is a forked network of 68 grain stores for storage of grain and industrial crops.



Dnipropetrovsk region is the leading in Ukraine in terms of the breeding business subjects' number and the quality of pedigree resources.

The genetic resources of dairy cattle breeding and pig breeding of the region are concentrated in 11 stud farms and 12 pedigree sow farms:

- in the dairy cattle breeding there are 8 stud farms and 7 pedigree sow farms;
- pig breeding of the region is represented by 3 stud farms and 5 pedigree sow farms.



In 2016, the volume of agricultural machinery production, in particular leavers and cultivators, increased by 9,5%.

MANUFACTURE OF FOOD PRODUCTS, BEVERAGES AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS

More than 130 enterprises are engaged in the food products production and agricultural products processing.

During 2016, enterprises of the region exported:

- ready-made food products for the amount of USD 110,0 mln;
- fats and oils - USD 289,4 mln.

The volume of capital investments in the production of food, beverages and tobacco products for 2016 amounted to USD 36,2 mln.

AGRICULTURAL COOPERATIVES

A promising area of entrepreneurship development in the agrarian sphere is the development of agricultural service cooperatives.

In 2016, 19 milk cooperatives produced 3 175 tons of high-quality milk. It is amounted to 2% of the total milk sold in the region.

In general, the share of private households in milk production is 76,2%, which is a promising direction for the formation of dairy cooperatives in the region.

Within the framework of the international projects of the Government of Canada, since 2008, organizational and educational work has been carried out to develop the cooperative movement in Dnipropetrovsk region in various areas.

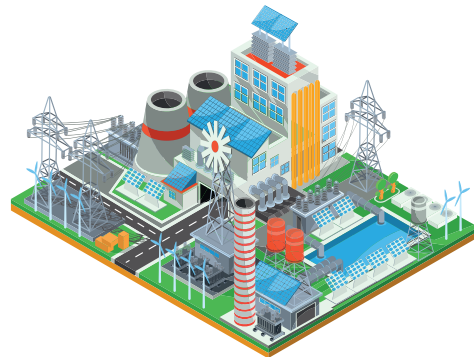
So, in 2017, within the framework of the project «Development of the dairy business in Ukraine», the second stage of the demonstration farm of the joint venture «Molocharske» was opened - a corps for 60 Holstein cows (the first stage - a casing for 60 cow of Jersey breed, opened in 2012).

The project «Development of granaries and agricultural cooperatives in Ukraine» provides for the construction of 57 thousand tons capacity grain storage on the basis of the agricultural cooperative «Zernovi» in Vasylykivka urban type settlement. In 2017, the first stage of a cooperative elevator with a 12,7 thousand tons capacity was built.

2.4. POWER INDUSTRY

Dnipropetrovsk region is one of the most energy-saturated in Ukraine. It takes the second place after Kyiv.

The energy generating industry of the region includes the following power generating enterprises: PJSC «Kryvyi Rih combined heat and power station» of «DTEK Dniproenergo» and PJSC «Prydniprovsk combined heat and power station, of DTEK Dniproenergo, Seredniodniprovsk hydroelectric power station branch of Ukrghidroenergo» and «Dniprodzerzhynsk thermal power station». In the region produced 5,6% of electricity production in Ukraine.

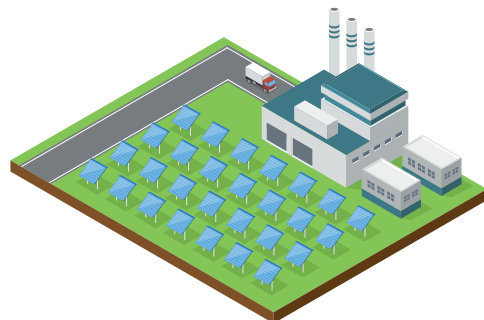

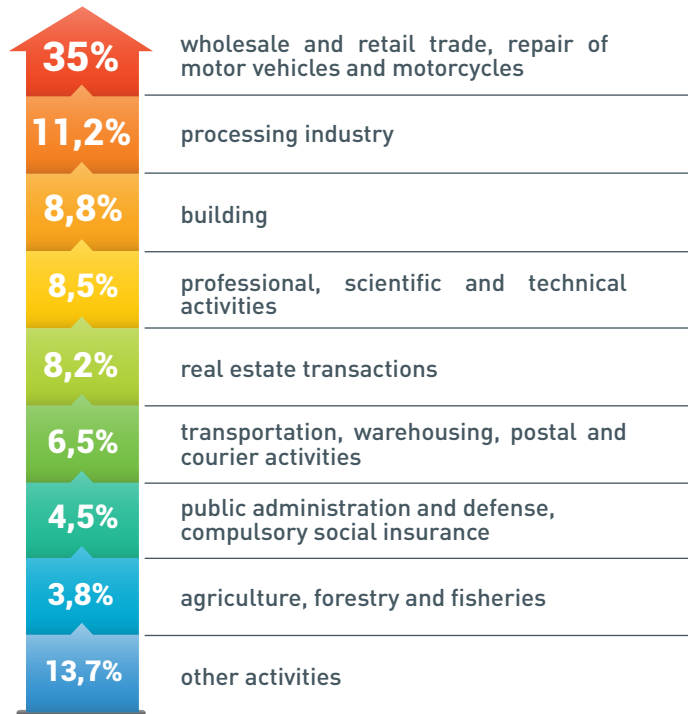


Dnipropetrovsk region is the second among the regions of Ukraine in terms of small and medium-sized enterprises number, which amounts to 36 726 units, 960 of which are medium businesses and 35 766 are small ones. 274 thousand persons (34,6% of the total working-age population in the region) are employed in the above-mentioned field.

The share of sold industrial products by regional small and medium-sized enterprises is 11,2% of the total SMEs sales volumes in Ukraine and ranks second after the capital.

From the total output of the region's enterprises, the output of SMEs is about 40%.

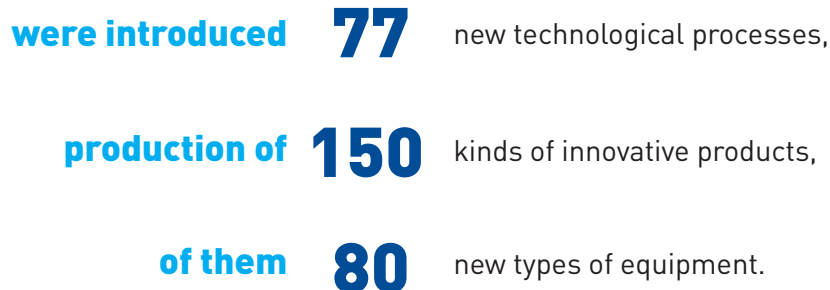
In Dnipro city, the international ITEM conference has already been held for the fifth year. This is the most significant IT-event in Ukraine.

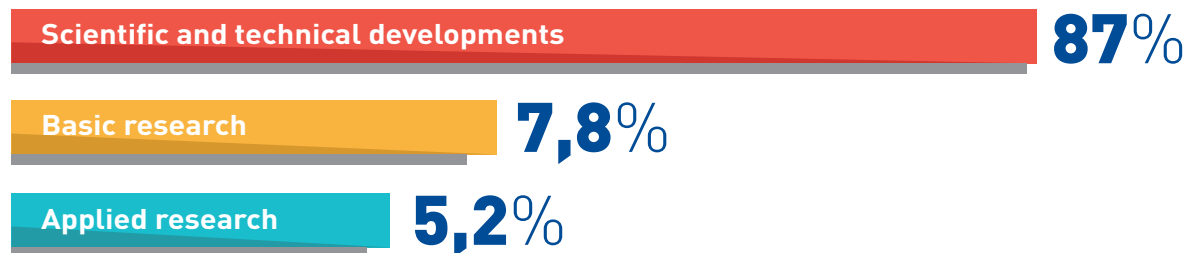

FREE TRADE AGREEMENTS

Ukraine is an associated member of the European Union, in accordance with the Association Agreement between Ukraine and the European Union, which entered into force in full from September 1, 2017. A part of this Agreement is the Deep and Comprehensive Free Trade Area between Ukraine and the EU.

In accordance with the above mentioned and taking into account other international agreements of Ukraine on free trade, enterprises of Dnipropetrovsk region have preferences in the framework of their export activities, in particular: cheaper production due to exemption from customs duties, reduction of time in trade through simplification of customs and transit procedures, creating favorable and stable business conditions for attracting investments and introducing new technologies.

In total, Ukraine has concluded 16 free trade agreements that cover the markets of 45 countries around the world (about 800 mln consumers):

Deep and Comprehensive Free Trade Areas, DCFTA.

The Free Trade Agreement between Ukraine and the member states of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) - Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein.

Agreements in the agriculture field between Ukraine and Norway, Ukraine and Iceland, Ukraine and Switzerland.

Free Trade Agreements between Ukraine and Canada, Montenegro, Macedonia, Georgia, and Moldova.

Free trade agreements between Ukraine and individual CIS countries (Azerbaijan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan and Belarus).

Within the framework of the Generalized System of Preferences, the WTO, the United States and Japan, Ukraine receives the possibility of duty-free importation into the territory of these countries more than 3 500 types of goods, including industrial and agricultural groups.

FOREIGN TRADE OF GOODS OF DNIPROPETROVSK REGION

In 2016, export of goods of the region amounted to USD 5 859,7 mln, import – USD 3 478,4 mln. The positive balance of foreign trade in goods amounted to USD 2 381,3 mln.

During the year, foreign trade relations were maintained with partners from 154 countries.

The export of goods to the countries of the European Union amounted to USD 1 661,5 mln and increased compared to 2015 by 23,3%. From European Union countries, goods were imported at USD 1 208,9 mln. Compared to 2015, this indicator increased by 6,2%.
