Εν λόγω πολυγεγονός στον τομέα της ενέργειας εντάσσεται στην «Εβδομάδα Βιωσιμότητος Άμπου Ντάμπι/Αbu Dhabi Sustainability Week» και αποσκοπεί στην προώθηση καινοτομίας, ανταλλαγή γνώσης, επιχειρηματική δικτύωση και διαμόρφωση πολιτικών, δίδοντας έμφαση σε τεχνολογίες ΑΠΕ, προϊόντα εξοικονόμησης ενέργειας, διαχείριση αποβλήτων και υδάτων και τεχνολογίες βιώσιμης ανάπτυξης. Η περασμένη διοργάνωση προσήλκυσε πάνω από 33χιλιάδες επισκέπτες από 170 χώρες, συγκεντρώνοντας 850 εκθέτες από 40 διαφορετικές χώρες των κλάδων πράσινων κατασκευών, διαχείρισης αποβλήτων/υδάτων, μεταφορών, ενέργειας, κλπ. Απετέλεσε δε εξαιρετική πλατφόρμα επιχειρηματικής δικτύωσης, σε οποία ανακοινώθηκαν συμφωνίες πάνω από 15δις δολ.ΗΠΑ.

Η Σύνοδος αποτελεί ένα φόρουμ συνάντησης στελεχών και υψηλών αξιωματούχων ιδιωτικού και δημοσίου τομέα, με σκοπό τον διάλογο και την ανταλλαγή γνώσης. Βασικές θεματικές που θα συζητηθούν είναι: βιοτεχνολογία, ύδρευση, διάστημα, τεχνολογία τροφίμων, κίνηση μέλλοντος και κλιματική αλλαγή.
